BOX CUTTER SAFETY TIPS: To prevent injuries while using one of the many types of box cutters, consider the following: Keep the Blade Sharp - Sharp blades will cut. Dull blades will tug and pull, which is more likely to cause your hand to slip and cut your fingers. Replace when dull, and never use a broken blade!
