The Army includes the Class A uniform in the service category consisting of the Class A, the Class B and the Dress uniform. The Class A is comparable to a suit. For men, the uniform includes a short or long-sleeved shirt, long tie, slacks and blazer/coat. For women, it includes a short or long-sleeved shirt, neck tab, slacks or skirt and blazer/coat.

Class A Uniform Inspection. Service Ribbons: worn in order of precedence from left to right in one or more rows with no more than four in a row and either no space or 1/8" between rows.

(2) The Army green Class B uniform includes the Army green trousers and AG shade 415 short- or long-sleeved shirt. Soldiers will wear a four-in-hand necktie with the long-sleeved AG shade 415 shirt when it is worn without the Army green (Class A) coat, as an outer garment (see figs 13-6 through 13-8).

Renamed Army Tan Uniform (shade 61) in 1959. Often worn by officers and NCOs with coat removed as a replacement for the issue Army Khaki Cotton Uniform.
